As you ride along the Thames Valley Parkway between Storybook Gardens at the West end and Meadowlily Road at the East end, you can look for these things along the way (assuming that you follow the provided 'Ride the TVP' route):

- A "Train Station" with a clock on the tower.
- A "castle" from a storybook.
- A statue of a slippery seal.
- Old Mother Hubbard's shoe house.
- The "Springbank Pumphouse" historical plaque.
- A "Share the Pathway" sign.
- At least 64 geese and 16 ducks. (Should be easy.)
- The "George Wenige" historical sign.
- An old bandshell.
- A sign that tells you how far it is to Halifax and Victoria.
- The "Marathon of Hope" sign.
- An old boat anchor.
- A memorial plaque to a London artist and cyclist.
- A very unique fence made of wood.
- Two "Beware of Flying Discs" signs.
- The "Meadowlily Bridge" historical sign.
- Two "London's Cycling History" signs.
- Two signs describing the history of "The Forks".
- Five "historical" signs.
- Two wrought iron bridges.
- Count how many bridges you cross over.
- Count how many bridges you pass under (tunnel counts as an 'under').
